Title: Emergency Arrangements

All staff are briefed at induction on the procedure to be followed in a rail emergency on site.

When deploying staff to a site controlled by a client, Matchtech will always endeavor to obtain a copy of the client's emergency arrangements and record that these have been briefed to Matchtech staff.

Staff awareness of emergency procedure is checked as part of Matchtech regular site audit programme.

In the event of an emergency, Matchtech will co-operate fully with Network Rail and any other interested parties by providing any information or other assistance which is required.

Matchtech can be contacted at any time in the event of an emergency, via the emergency telephone number. This number is briefed to staff.

Matchtech will ensure that all emergencies affecting our staff working on Rail projects will be fully investigated and reported in accordance with our internal accident and incident reporting policy and procedure.

Matchtech emergency arrangements are reviewed regularly as part of the interim audits carried out by Bridgeway Consulting. They are also reviewed following any emergency involving Matchtech staff.
