Think Safe, Act Safe and Be Safe

Sentinel Scheme Rules:

- Everyone who has a **Sentinel Smart Card** must comply with the **Sentinel Scheme Rules**. If you are receiving this Safety Briefing you are a **Sentinel Smart Cardholder**. This means you are accountable for providing **accurate personal information** to Resourcing Solutions (your **Primary Sponsor**) and for keeping it up to date.
- You can contact Resourcing Solutions to update any details by using the information on the last page of this Safety Briefing.
- Alleged breaches of the Sentinel Scheme Rules shall be investigated by Resourcing Solutions (your Primary Sponsor). The Sub-Sponsor putting an Individual to work at the time of the alleged breach shall assist in collating information and supporting the Primary Sponsors Local Investigation where applicable.
- Every Sentinel Smart Cardholder has a personal responsibility to comply with health and safety rules; including, but not limited to:
- Do not exceed working time limits and only report for duty if fit to work, not fatigued.
- Wear appropriate PPE and undertake work you are competent to do.
